We have recently been in contact with your appointed broker Perkins Slade Limited regarding several concerns over the cover provided by our policy.

As Insurers of the risk we can assure our Policyholder the below statements are all correct:

**RSA is regulated to transact business in Ireland**

We have the capability to write business in over 130 countries, and have major operations in the UK, Scandinavia, Canada, Ireland, Asia and the Middle East and Latin America. Focusing only on general insurance, we have around 22,000 employees and, in 2009 our net written premiums were £6.73bn.

**RSA policy wording is valid in Ireland and complies with Irish Law**

**RSA will pay claims in Ireland**

The Policy is issued by RSA Dublin. The policy is not written on a Freedom of Services basis and so claims will be handled from RSA Dublin.

**The Irish levy is paid over to RSA Dublin**


This is rigorously controlled within RSA in both the UK and in Dublin. This process is subject to internal and external audit and is subject to stringent punitive costs to RSA if the Tax and Levy regulations are not strictly applied. The process of transferring the Irish levy is controlled by the RSA Central Accounting Unit based in Liverpool.

**The RSA documentation is compliant in Ireland**

The document has been authorised by the Multinational Team who control and regulate the content of Policy Wordings used by RSA globally.

Please also note premiums can be collected in either Sterling or Euros therefore collecting premium in Euros will not be an issue for 2011 Renewal. This is ultimately customers discretion as to whether the premium is paid in Sterling or Euros.
